

## Post-Op Instructions

- 1. Keep area dry for 24-48 Hours after the day of procedure. You may shower same day as surgery, but surgery site must remain dry for 24 to 48 hours.
- 2. After the 24-48 hours you can cleanse the wound site with a mild soap (example: Dove unscented) and water. Doing this twice daily for 7 to 14 days.
- 3. Pat dry the area (note: don't scrub the wound site) then apply a film of POLYSPORIN OINTMENT (the ointment can be purchased over the counter). Again applying this twice daily for 7 to 14 days. With a new bandage every time.
- 4. If you have any pain or discomfort you can take Tylenol extra strength (which is over the counter) if needed. If pain persists please call the office.
- 5. If you should develop a bruise or any swelling place an ice pack 15min every hour on the hour until bedtime for up to 2 days if needed. (A bag of frozen peas or a clean cloth with ice).
- 6. If the wound site should develop blood, bandage the surgery site and apply direct pressure for 20 minutes. If oozing persists give the office a call 626-852-3376.
- 7. If you are on a blood thinner like Coumadin, Plavix, or any form of aspirin you may resume it, but please check with the office prior to resuming your medication.
- 8. If you are given an antibiotic please take them until they are finished, this will help prevent infection.
